

RULES OF THE CONTEST - .eu RAIL CONNECT (“Rules”)

Eligibility

- The Contest is open to all natural persons aged eighteen (18) or over (the “Eligible Participants”).
- Employees of EURid vzw, its affiliates, subsidiaries, and immediate family members and/or those living in the same household are not eligible to participate in the Contest.
- Winning a prize is contingent upon fulfilling all the requirements set forth herein.
- To participate in the Play to Win mode, participants must enter a valid .eu domain name and corresponding postal code. To verify eligibility, EURid will check the submitted domain name and postal code against the registrant data held in its database.

Administrator

The Contest is administrated by EURid vzw, with company registration number 0864 240 405, based in Telecomlaan 9, 1831 Diegem, Belgium (“Eurid”) and is exclusively subject to Belgian law.

Entry

Eligible Participants may enter the Contest by participating in the online game **EURAIL CONNECT**, accessible via EURid’s official website and [.eu Rail Connect | EURid](#) during the Contest Period. The game provides two modes of participation:

Play for Fun (Non-Contest Mode)

The Play for Fun mode is open to all visitors without any restrictions. Participants may play as many times as they wish; however, scores obtained in this mode do not count toward the Contest and Participants in this mode cannot win any prize.

Play to Win (Contest Mode)

To participate in the Contest, a Participant must enter a valid .eu domain name and the postal code linked to that domain name.

Upon starting the game, Participants must solve a digital puzzle within the allotted time.

- Participants who solve the puzzle receive two (2) attempts to guess how many players have participated in the game that day.
- Participants who do not solve the puzzle receive one (1) attempt to make their guess.

Only entries submitted in Play to Win mode will be considered for determining the daily winner. Each domain name may participate only once per day in the Play to Win mode.

EURid reserves the right to disqualify any person who does not adhere to the rules or specifications.

Contest Period

- The Contest will run from 1 April 2026 until 30 April 2026 (the “Contest Period”).
- Participants may access the online game EURAIL CONNECT via EURid’s official website and [.eu Rail Connect | EURid](#) throughout the Contest Period. All valid Play to Win entries submitted during a given calendar day within the Contest Period will be considered for selecting that day’s winner.
- Daily winners will be determined based on the entries recorded during that specific calendar day, in accordance with the rules set out in the “Winner Selection and Notification” clause.
- EURid reserves the right to temporarily suspend or limit access to the game in the event of technical maintenance, security issues, or circumstances beyond its control. Where feasible, such interruptions will be communicated on the Contest webpage.

Prize

One (1) winner will be selected for each day of the Contest. The winner will be the registrant of the domain name, as recorded in EURid’s registration database, corresponding to the domain name submitted in the Play to Win mode.

Each daily winner will receive two (2) Interrail Global Passes (7 days within 1 month). The passes will be provided as digital activation codes, redeemable through the Interrail mobile application.

If the registrant is a legal entity, the legal entity will be deemed the winner and must designate a natural person to whom the prize will be assigned.

Prizes are strictly personal, nontransferable and may not be exchanged for cash or any other alternative.

Winners will receive instructions on how to activate and use the Interrail passes once EURid has received all necessary identification details required for prize issuance. EURid cannot be held responsible for any restrictions, limitations or conditions attached to the use of Interrail passes, including (but not limited to) travel eligibility, app requirements or geographical limitations imposed by the Interrail system.

Winners Selection and Notification

The daily winner will be the Participant who submits the guess that is closest to the total number of players who participated in the game on that same day. In the event that two or more Participants submit guesses that are equally close to the correct number, the final winner will be determined by means of a random draw.

For the purposes of the Contest, the winner will be the registrant of the domain name as recorded in EURid’s registration database, corresponding to the domain name submitted in the Play to Win mode. If the registrant is a legal entity, the registrant must designate a natural person to whom the prize will be assigned.

A registrant may only win once during the entire Contest Period.

Winners will be contacted by EURid after the end of the Contest Period.

To enable prize delivery, winners will be requested to provide the following information:

- First and last name
- Date of birth
- Nationality
- Country of residence
- ID card number

If a winner does not provide the required information within the timeframe set by EURid, the prize may be forfeited. In such case, we reserve the right to select the next eligible participant in line as an alternative winner.

Publicity

By entering the Contest, participants agree to allow EURid to use their name, likeness, and entry for promotional and marketing purposes without further compensation.

Privacy Policy

- By participating to the Contest, Winners give consent for EURid to obtain their names, e-mail address and postal code and domain name for the sole purpose of administering this Contest and contacting the Winners.
- In no event will personal data of Winners or participants be used for marketing purposes or disclosed to third parties without the Winners' prior consent.
- The personal data of participants will be retained by EURid for a reasonable period after the Contest and the Prize redemption Period in order to operate the Contest in a consistent manner, and to deal with any queries from participants.
- Otherwise, any personal data relating to the participants or Winners will be processed in accordance with EURid's privacy policy available at <https://eurid.eu/en/privacy-policy/>

Limitation of Liability

- EURid shall not be liable for any direct, indirect, incidental, consequential, or punitive damages arising out of or in connection with the competition, including but not limited to technical malfunctions, lost or delayed entries, or any injuries or damages resulting from participation in the competition or acceptance of prizes.
- EURid cannot be held liable for any change to the Rules, for the cancellation of the Competition in case of force majeure or for any other reason beyond EURid's control.
- By mere participation in the Contest, each participant accepts these Rules as well as any possible decision by EURid related to the Contest. In case of disputes, EURid's decision will be final, binding and cannot be contested. No correspondence will be entered into regarding the Contest, the outcome thereof, or the application of the Rules.

Technical Provisions

Availability

The Contest is offered through an online game made available on EURid's official website. EURid does not guarantee uninterrupted or error-free access to the game. Access may be temporarily unavailable due to technical issues, maintenance, high traffic volumes or circumstances beyond EURid's control. In such cases, EURid shall not be held liable for any inability to participate or submit an entry.

Device, Browser and Compatibility Disclaimer

The performance of the game may vary depending on the Participant's device, operating system, browser configuration, internet connection and other technical factors. EURid does not guarantee that the game will function on all devices or with all software configurations. Participants are responsible for ensuring their device and connection are sufficient to access and play the game.

Submission and Timestamp

Only entries that are successfully received and recorded by the game system will be considered valid. EURid is not responsible for late, lost, incomplete, corrupted, or delayed entries, including those resulting from network issues, browser delays, caching behaviour, or other technical factors. The system timestamp recorded by EURid's servers shall be considered final.

Anti-Cheating and Fair Play

Participants must play the game fairly and may not use any automated means, bots, scripts, macros, or other methods to manipulate gameplay, bypass restrictions, or artificially influence results, including the daily player count or the one-entry-per-day limit.

EURid reserves the right to disqualify any Participant or domain name suspected of engaging in fraudulent, disruptive, or abusive behaviour.

Data Integrity

EURid is not responsible for any technical failures that affect the integrity of data submitted through the game, including but not limited to corrupted entries, incomplete transmissions or system errors. Only the data effectively captured and stored by EURid's systems at the time of submission will be used for Contest purposes.

Cybersecurity and Platform Misuse

Participants may not attempt to damage, disrupt, overload, hack, reverse engineer or otherwise interfere with the operation of the game or website. Any attempt to do so will result in immediate disqualification and may lead to reporting to relevant authorities where appropriate.

Fair Participation Measures

EURid reserves the right to take reasonable measures to protect the integrity of the Contest, including blocking or limiting access where repeated attempts or unusual activity suggest misuse of the participation rules.

Modification or Interruption of the Contest

If technical issues, maintenance operations, or other events affect the functioning, fairness, security or administration of the Contest, EURid reserves the right to modify, suspend, or interrupt gameplay or the Contest itself. If feasible, relevant information will be provided on the Contest webpage.

Online Communication

All communication with winners—including the request for winner information and delivery of prize-related instructions—will occur electronically. EURid is not responsible for undelivered messages resulting from incorrect email addresses, spam filters, mailbox settings, technical issues or other factors beyond its control.

Digital Prize Delivery

EURid is not responsible for delays or failure in prize delivery caused by incorrect winner information, technical restrictions on the winner's devices, or issues with accessing or redeeming digital codes.

Terms and Conditions

- EURid reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Contest, should a cause beyond EURid's control corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness or proper conduct of the Contest.
- By entering this Contest, participants are indicating their agreement to be bound by the Contest Rules and EURid's decision.
