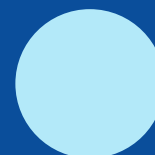

How to report abuse and submit legal requests for .eu domain names.

Reporting malicious or abusive .eu domain names to EURid

You can report suspected malicious or abusive .eu domain names to EURid.

Once a report is received, EURid starts the verification process of the domain name holder's data. If the domain name holder does not respond, the domain name will be suspended in due course.

To submit a report, please send an email to abuse@eurid.eu.

Include **all domain names** you would like us to review, listed together **in a single message**.

Requesting WHOIS registration data for a .eu domain name holder

WHOIS registration data disclosure is available to all legitimate access seekers within the EEA. There is no requirement to first contact Europol or the Belgian authorities.

How to submit a request

- 1 Go to: link.eurid.eu/datadisclosure or scan the QR-code
- 2 Select **“Request form for registration data disclosure”**
- 3 Complete the form and send it to legal@eurid.eu



Requests are processed within **72 hours of receipt**. Urgent requests are handled within 24 hours.

EURid's Registration Data Disclosure Policy is **aligned with the Belgian NIS2 Act of 26 April 2024**.

Registrars have access to payment and customer data. Registries only to registration and verification data.

Requesting the seizure and/or redirection of .eu domain names

A Belgian public prosecutor or judge may issue an order to seize and/or redirect a .eu domain name under specific legal provisions.

The order must include:

- **Addressee:** EURid vzw
- **Legal basis** (e.g. Article 39bis of the Belgian Criminal Procedure Code; Article XVII.34/1 of the Belgian Code of Economic Law)
- **Domain name(s)** concerned
- **Nameserver(s)** for redirection, if applicable
- **Date of execution** (immediate or a specific date)

Please send the order to legal@eurid.eu.

EURid will enforce a valid legal order without delay, seizing and/or redirecting the domain name as instructed.

Suspending or redirecting a domain name does **not remove its content**. To request content removal, please contact the domain's registrar or hosting provider.
